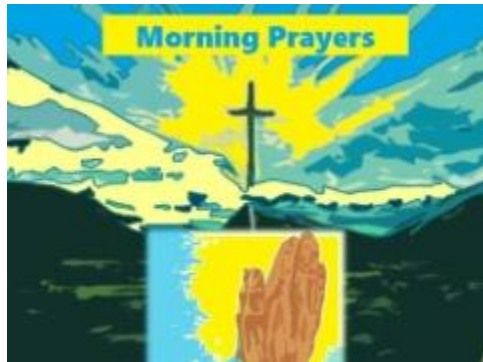


Jenaministries – Part 14 Morning Prayers
